

one-on-one guidance by trained clinical staff. The sessions provide for muscle strengthening and aerobic capacity drills tailored to each individual's condition. Patients will also receive nutrition education and, if necessary, smoking cessation instructions.

"The goal of pulmonary rehab is to reduce patients' symptoms, increase their participation in physical and social activities, and improve their overall quality of life," said Penny Oyler, BRMC's director of Cardiopulmonary Services.

Enrolling in the pulmonary rehabilitation program requires a physician's referral. Patients are encouraged to contact their doctor for a referral to the new program.

"Pulmonary rehabilitation is an integral part of the clinical management and health maintenance of those patients with chronic respiratory disease who remain symptomatic or continue to have decreased function despite standard medical treatment," said Frank Arnal, M.D., F.C.C.P., the pulmonary medical director at BRMC. Dr. Arnal is board certified in Pulmonary, Internal, Critical Care and Sleep Medicine.

**EMERALD ASH BORER (EAB) INFORMATIONAL
MEETING OPEN TO THE PUBLIC**
Cornell University Cooperative Extension will host an informational public meeting regarding the Emerald Ash Borer (EAB) on Wednesday, June 30th, at 7pm at the Randolph Fire Hall, located at 70 Main Street in Randolph. Please note that the fire hall is located behind the Randolph Municipal Building at 72 Main Street.

At the upcoming meeting, Cornell University, DEC and NYS Ag & Markets experts will be present to share information and answer questions on the EAB. The meeting will offer area residents and public officials an opportunity to learn more about the EAB, what actions individuals and communities can take to help reduce the spread and minimize economic impacts of the EAB, and the ongoing efforts in place to address the current EAB infestation. Anyone interested is welcome and encouraged to attend the meeting.

The EAB is a small but destructive beetle that infests and kills North American ash tree species, including green, white, black and blue ash. A multi-agency effort is underway to address the EAB infestation and includes partners from the state Department of Agriculture and Markets; U.S. Department of Agriculture Animal Plant Health Inspection Service (APHIS); the United States Forest Service; the State Office of Parks, Recreation and Historic Preservation; the State Emergency Management Office; State Department of Transportation; Cornell Cooperative Extension; and the Seneca Nation.

Conditions that can induce heat-related illnesses include stagnant atmospheric conditions and poor air quality. Consequently, people living in urban areas may be at greater risk from the effects of a prolonged heat wave than those living in rural areas.

During extremely hot weather, you should take the following precautions: • Stay indoors as much as you can, on lower floors if possible. • Limit exposure to the sun and use sun block with a high sun protector factor rating (at least 15 spf) if you must be outdoors. • If your home does not have air conditioning, spend the hottest part of the day in public buildings such as libraries, schools, movie theaters, shopping malls, and other community facilities. • Use fans. Circulating air can cool the body by increasing the perspiration rate of evaporation. • If you have window air conditioning, eliminate any holes or gaps around the installation. • Check air-conditioning ducts for proper insulation. • Eat well-balanced, light, and regular meals. Avoid using salt tablets unless directed to do so by a physician. • Drink plenty of water. Persons who have epilepsy or heart, kidney, or liver disease; are on fluid-restricted diets; or have a problem with fluid retention should consult a doctor before increasing liquid intake. • Limit intake of alcoholic beverages. • Dress in loose-fitting, lightweight, and light-colored clothes that cover as much skin as possible. • Protect your face and head by wearing a wide-brimmed hat. • Check on family, friends, and neighbors who do not have air conditioning and who spend much of their time alone. • Never leave children or pets alone in closed vehicles. • Avoid strenuous work during the warmest part of the day, 11 a.m. to 4 p.m.. Have a buddy system when working in extreme heat, and take frequent breaks. • Exercise should be done in the early morning hours between 4-7 a.m. • Make sure there is enough food and water for pets.

Heat-Induced Illnesses

Exposure to extreme heat can cause serious illness. Heat Cramps are painful spasms, usually in leg and abdominal muscles, and may be accompanied by heavy sweating. Heat Exhaustion is more serious. Symptoms include heavy sweating, but skin may be cool, pale, or flushed. Fainting or dizziness, weak pulse, nausea, vomiting, exhaustion, and headaches may occur.

If you experience any of these symptoms, sit or lie down in a cool place, loosen your clothing, and sip half a glass of

water every 15 minutes. Discontinue drinking water if you become nauseous, and seek immediate medical attention if vomiting occurs.

Heat Stroke is a severe medical emergency and can be life-threatening. Symptoms include a high body temperature, as much as 105 degrees; hot, red, dry skin; rapid, weak pulse; rapid shallow breathing; and possible loss of consciousness. If you suspect you have heat stroke, seek immediate medical assistance or call 911.

Sunburn is a common summer problem. In severe cases it can cause swelling, blisters, fever, and headaches. Take a shower using soap to remove oils that may block pores, preventing the body from cooling naturally. Apply dry, sterile dressings to any blisters and, if they persist, see a doctor.

Energy Conservation • Power outages are more likely to occur during warm weather, when utility usage is at its peak.

TYPE O NEGATIVE BLOOD SUPPLY DROPS TO CRITICALLY LOW LEVELS

Red Cross Asks Eligible Volunteer Blood Donors to Help Make Up For Shortfall

June 14, 2010 - The supply of type O negative blood at the American Red Cross has dropped to critically low levels. Type O negative blood is always in high demand because it can be transfused to patients with any blood type, especially in emergency situations. Type O negative donors are needed now to help prevent the type O negative blood supply from declining further.

"The American Red Cross is extending blood drive hours and reaching out to eligible blood donors, sponsors and community leaders to ask them to help recruit type O negative blood donations to help make up for this shortfall," says Donna M. Morrissey, spokesperson for the American Red Cross Blood Services - Northeast Division.

"While all blood types are needed during the summer months, we urge those eligible donors with O negative blood type to make and keep appointments to give blood in the upcoming days to help restore the inventory level," Morrissey added.

"The Red Cross monitors the blood inventory on a daily basis and when we see a trend or shortage emerging, we communicate the need to our generous blood donors to help us make up the shortfall," said Morrissey.

Eligible volunteer blood donors are asked to please call 1-800-RED CROSS (1-800-733-2767) or visit www.redcrossblood.org to find a blood drive and to make

appointments.

A shortage of type O negative blood often occurs during the summer months when fewer donors are giving because of summer vacations and schools approaching summer break are hosting fewer drives.

Every two seconds, someone in the United States needs blood. The Red Cross New York - Penn Blood Services Region provides lifesaving blood to 120 hospitals and must have 1,200 people give blood and platelets each weekday to meet hospital demand. Accident victims as well as patients with cancer, sickle cell disease, blood disorders and other illnesses receive lifesaving transfusions every day. There is no substitute for blood and volunteer donors are the only source.

Individuals who are 17 years of age (16 with parental permission in some states), meet weight and height requirements (110 pounds or more, depending on their height) and are in generally good health may be eligible to give blood. Air Conditioner Leaves Him Sweating

Q: My air conditioner, a whole-house unit, doesn't seem to be cooling things down very well this year. It's about 12 years old. We never had a problem, but now we're usually sweating indoors in the afternoon. Is there anything I can do to improve its performance? -- Chuck in Ocala, Fla.

A: You can (and should) check around the outdoor unit to make sure no debris is blocking any of the vents and that there is no visible damage to the unit. You also can switch out the air-conditioning filter inside the house -- something that should be done monthly during the summer. Another component to look at is the thermostat. There's a possibility that it's not setting the temperature correctly, particularly if it's an older analog thermostat.

For an analog thermostat (one on which you turn a dial or move a lever to the desired temperature), have a helper go over to your home's heating unit -- rather than the air conditioner, unless you only have an air conditioner. Turn the selector to "heat" and "auto" and set the dial to a high temperature. Your helper should hear a click or other sound as the furnace acknowledges the signal. (If you have only AC, which is still somewhat common in Florida, set the thermostat to "auto" and turn the dial to a very cool temperature. The AC may take a couple of minutes to come on.)

If your thermostat is digital, check and see if it uses batteries. If so, replace them with fresh ones and proceed with the above test.

You also can have an electrician come and test the thermostat to make sure it's operating correctly or if it needs to be replaced. Replacing a thermostat is very low-cost and might solve the problem.

If the thermostat isn't the issue, call an AC repair specialist to look at the unit. Twelve years in a hot climate is a long time for a central-air unit to operate -- most are warranted for 10 years max -- so it might be on its last legs.

HOME TIP: Schedule a checkup for your heating or air-conditioning unit every year before the season starts with a licensed heating/AC specialist.




