**PICKS OF THE WEEK**

"The Fighter" (R) -- Directed by David O. Russell ("Three Kings"), "The Fighter" is an above-average boxing movie about the real-life story of Micky Ward (Mark Wahlberg) and his unconventional road to winning the light-welterweight title.

Like most sports movies, "The Fighter" hammers home most of the usual cliches: A plucky underdog from the wrong side of the tracks overcomes the odds to win the championship, etc. But thanks to some good performances by Wahlberg and Christian Bale (who plays his crack-addict brother), "The Fighter" rises slightly above the usual melodramatic fare we're accustomed to.

"Hereafter" (PG-13) -- As director Clint Eastwood edges ever closer to the sweet release that only death can bring, it seems only natural that his latest film tackles the concept of The Afterlife.

Matt Damon stars as George Loney, a blue-collar fella who acquired psychic abilities following a childhood illness. His brother (Jay Mohr) wants to turn George into a celebrity, but he'd rather try to live a normal life with his girlfriend (Bryce Dallas Howard). Meanwhile, a French journalist (Cécile De France) has a near-death experience

following a natural disaster in India and a London boy named Marcus (Frankie McLaren) suffers the loss of his twin brother and is sent to foster care.

Through a series of events, George, the journalist and Marcus find each other as they seek answers to the mysteries of life and death.

## IRS Announces New Effort to Help Struggling Taxpayers Get a Fresh Start

### Major Changes Made to Lien Process

WASHINGTON - In its latest effort to help struggling taxpayers, the Internal Revenue Service recently announced a series of new steps to help people get a fresh start with their tax liabilities.

The goal is to help individuals and small businesses meet their tax obligations, without adding unnecessary burden to taxpayers. Specifically, the IRS is announcing new policies and programs to help taxpayers pay back taxes and avoid tax liens.

"We are making fundamental changes to our lien system and other collection tools that will help taxpayers and give them a fresh start," IRS Commissioner Doug Shulman said. "These steps are good for people facing tough times, and they reflect a responsible approach for the tax system."

The changes include:

- Significantly increasing the dollar threshold when liens are generally issued, resulting in fewer tax liens.
- Making it easier for taxpayers to obtain lien withdrawals after paying a tax bill.
- Withdrawing liens in most cases where a taxpayer enters into a Direct Debit Installment Agreement.
- Creating easier access to Installment Agreements for more struggling small businesses.
- Expanding a streamlined Offer in Compromise program to cover more taxpayers.

"These steps are in the best interest of both

taxpayers and the tax system," Shulman said. "People will have a better chance to stay current on their taxes and keep their financial house in order. We all benefit if that happens."

This is another in a series of steps to help struggling taxpayers. In 2008, the IRS announced lien relief for people trying to refinance or sell a home. In 2009, the IRS added new flexibility for taxpayers facing payment or collection problems. And last year, the IRS held about 1,000 special open houses to help small businesses and individuals resolve tax issues with the Agency.

Today's announcement comes after a review of collection operations which Shulman launched last year, as well as input from the Internal Revenue Service Advisory Council and the National Taxpayer Advocate.

### Tax Lien Thresholds

The IRS will significantly increase the dollar thresholds when liens are generally filed. The new dollar amount is in keeping with inflationary changes since the number was last revised. Currently, liens are automatically filed at certain dollar levels for people with past-due balances.

The IRS plans to review the results and impact of the lien threshold change in about a year.

A federal tax lien gives the IRS a legal claim to a taxpayer's property for the amount of an unpaid tax debt. Filing a Notice of Federal Tax Lien is necessary to establish priority rights against certain other creditors. Usually the government is not the only creditor to whom the taxpayer owes money.

A lien informs the public that the U.S. government has a claim against all property, and any rights to property, of the taxpayer.

This includes property owned at the time the notice of lien is filed and any acquired thereafter. A lien can affect a taxpayer's credit rating, so it is critical to arrange the payment of taxes as quickly as possible.

"Raising the lien threshold keeps pace with inflation and makes sense for the tax system," Shulman said. "These changes mean tens of thousands of people won't be burdened by liens, and this step will take place without significantly increasing the financial risk to the government."

### Tax Lien Withdrawals

The IRS will also modify procedures that will make it easier for taxpayers to obtain lien withdrawals.

Liens will now be withdrawn once full payment of taxes is made if the taxpayer requests it. The IRS has determined that this approach is in the best interest of the government.

In order to speed the withdrawal process, the IRS will also streamline its internal procedures to allow collection personnel to withdraw the liens.

### Direct Debit Installment Agreements and Liens

The IRS is making other fundamental changes to liens in cases where taxpayers enter into a Direct Debit Installment Agreement (DDIA). For taxpayers with unpaid assessments of \$25,000 or less, the IRS will now allow lien withdrawals under several scenarios:

- Lien withdrawals for taxpayers entering into a Direct Debit Installment Agreement.
- The IRS will withdraw a lien if a taxpayer on a regular Installment Agreement converts to a Direct Debit Installment Agreement.
- The IRS will also withdraw liens on existing Direct Debit Installment agreements upon taxpayer request.

Liens will be withdrawn after a probationary period demonstrating that direct debit payments will be honored.

In addition, this lowers user fees and saves the government money from mailing monthly payment notices. Taxpayers can use the Online Payment Agreement application on IRS.gov to set-up with Direct Debit Installment Agreements.

"We are trying to minimize burden on taxpayers while collecting the proper amount of tax," Shulman said. "We believe taking away taxpayer burden makes sense when a taxpayer has taken the proactive step of entering a direct debit agreement."

### Installment Agreements and Small Businesses

The IRS will also make streamlined Installment Agreements available to more small businesses. The payment program will raise the dollar limit to allow additional small businesses to participate.

Small businesses with \$25,000 or less in unpaid tax can participate. Currently, only small businesses with under \$10,000 in liabilities can participate. Small businesses will have 24 months to pay.

The streamlined Installment Agreements will be available for small businesses that file either as an individual or as a business. Small businesses with an unpaid assessment balance greater than \$25,000 would qualify for the streamlined Installment Agreement if they pay down the balance to \$25,000 or less.

Small businesses will need to enroll in a Direct Debit Installment Agreement to participate.

"Small businesses are an important part of the nation's economy, and the IRS should help them when we can," Shulman said. "By expanding payment options, we can help small businesses pay their tax bill while freeing up cash flow to keep funding their operations."

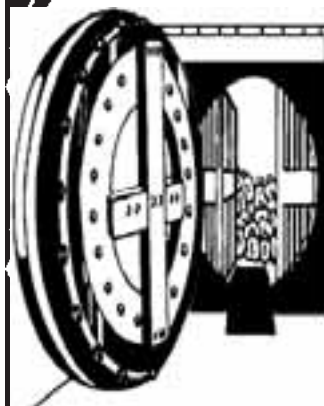

a new streamlined Offer in Compromise (OIC) program to cover a larger group of struggling taxpayers.

This streamlined OIC is being expanded to allow taxpayers with annual incomes up to \$100,000 to participate. In addition, participants must have tax liability of less than \$50,000, doubling the current limit of \$25,000 or less.

OICs are subject to acceptance based on legal

requirements. An offer-in-compromise is an agreement between a taxpayer and the IRS that settles the taxpayer's tax liabilities for less than the full amount owed. Generally, an offer will not be accepted if the IRS believes that the liability can be paid in full as a lump sum or through a payment agreement. The IRS looks at the taxpayer's income and assets to make a determination regarding the taxpayer's ability to pay.

**PAW'S CORNER**

By Sam Mazzotta-Midnight Rambler

**DEAR PAW'S CORNER:** I have an 8-year-old Schnauzer, "Fixer," who has recently started getting into things during the night, after I'm in bed. He has torn open bags, taken things from my purse and gotten into my grandkids' arts and crafts box. Now I have to be careful not to leave anything around. We have not changed the way we are doing things. Could this be his age? -- Phyllis H., Rochester, N.Y.

**DEAR PHYLLIS:** I'd be remiss if I didn't recommend you take him to the veterinarian first thing, just to make sure there is no underlying health issue causing his sudden behavioral change.

If everything checks out, tackle the problem from two angles. First, even though you haven't changed his daily schedule, something subtle may have changed in the house or yard. Pay attention to nighttime happenings. Is there some new noise outside? Did something happen while you were asleep, perhaps, that may have caused Fixer to become anxious?

Next, make some changes in his day and night routine that will help him feel more secure when you're asleep. Extend his evening walk a bit and add some basic obedience training and play time to the evening schedule. When it's your bedtime, lead Fixer over to his bedding and have him lie down and stay. Check back in five minutes, then in 30; if he's still in his bed, praise him and give him a little treat. If he's not in his bed, lead him back and repeat. Place a favorite chew toy next to him.

At first, Fixer will hop right back out once he thinks you're asleep and proceed with his nightly rummaging. Be patient. It will take some time for him to associate this routine with the idea that you want him to stay there at night. Meantime, keep placing people things out of reach. Put doggie toys in their place.

**THIS IS A HAMMER**  
By Samantha Mazzotta  
Broken Bulb Blues

Q: I was trying to unscrew a burnt-out light bulb yesterday, which unfortunately stuck and then broke as I tried to force it to turn. I wasn't hurt, but now I have a jagged remnant stuck in the socket. I'm afraid to turn that light on, but it's the ceiling light in my den, and I'd really like to be able to work there. Any suggestions? Also, what do you think of those new fluorescent light bulbs? -- Derek N., Youngstown, Ohio

A: First, turn off the circuit breaker to that room to make sure no electricity is getting to the socket. Second, put on a sturdy work glove and place a wastebasket nearby to discard the bulb. Third, take a raw potato or a piece of soap. Cut the potato in half and trim to slightly larger than the diameter of the socket. Press the trimmed part of the potato or soap against the jagged edges of the broken bulb. Then, slowly turn counterclockwise to unscrew. You may need to brace the socket with your free hand or with a pair of needle-nose pliers if it tries to twist with the bulb.

If this doesn't work, contact an electrician to remove the bulb and inspect the socket for damage.

As to your second question regarding CFL (compact fluorescent lamp) bulbs, well, they're the wave of the future -- like it or not. The last U.S.-manufactured incandescent light bulb rolled off the production lines last year. The ones on store shelves now are produced overseas. CFLs do produce the same amount of light while using significantly less power, so you may see a slight difference in your power bill if all your home's bulbs are CFLs. The cost of a CFL is higher than that of an incandescent bulb, but that price is coming down. Additionally, CFLs last much longer than incandescents, so you won't be purchasing them as often. By the way, if you break a glass-coil CFL bulb, the soap/potato trick isn't effective. Wear sturdy work gloves and grip the socket and the small extension from which the CFL's glass coil protruded and carefully unscrew it.

**HOME TIP:** Light bulb flickering? Before changing it or calling an electrician, try removing the bulb and cleaning its base with a pencil eraser. A clean contact may solve the problem.

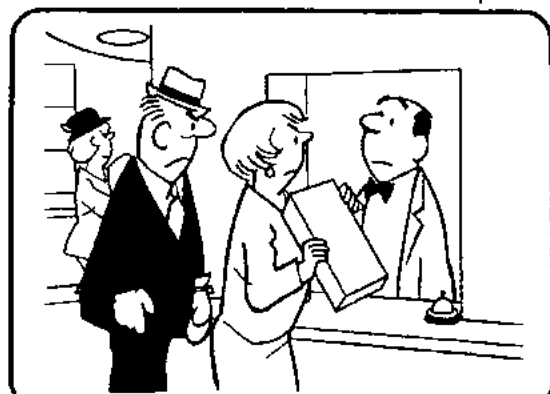

Who Can Dethrone Jimmie Johnson?  
As the 2011 season gets under way, one NASCAR driver after another  
remarked that the sport had never been so competitive.  
Say what? The same guy has won the past five championships!  
By definition, the level of competition is lower, not higher, when one  
guy wins all the time. The guy's name, of course, is Jimmie Johnson. He  
has the best crew chief (Chad Knaus), and the two of them work for the  
best team (Hendrick Motorsports).  
Since Johnson debuted in NASCAR's premier series, now Sprint Cup,  
in 2002, it hasn't been competitive at all. He's won 53 races, almost twice  
as many as any other driver. During that span, Tony Stewart is second with  
27. Jeff Gordon has 24.  
No signs of weakness darken the perennial champion's outlook.  
"Well, it's obviously a new year and new set of challenges," said  
Johnson. "It's awfully early to even understand what the challenges are  
going to be. We hope that we're smarter through all the hard work that  
we've been going through in the offseason. We're working hard on all  
fronts to be a better race team."  
"Last year we learned a lot more about ourselves and kind of validated  
our core beliefs and stuck to what the (No.) 48 team is known for and  
what we believe in, and were still able to overcome a lot of adversity and  
win a championship. I feel like we'll be stronger and better, but we just  
don't know until we get into the meat of the season, and the first goal is  
obviously to make the Chase and from there figure out how to win again."

What could make NASCAR more competitive? Why, beating Johnson  
would be a good start.

Seldom has excellence been less appreciated. The easygoing Johnson  
is an unlikely villain. He is good-natured, reasonably frank and  
cooperative. He cheerfully upholds his obligations. Few of his detractors  
in the grandstand would dislike him if they knew him personally.

What Johnson, in his No. 48 Lowe's Chevy, has done in nine seasons,  
not just the past five, is incredible. He has never finished worse than fifth  
in the standings. Over the span of his career, Johnson has also dominated  
the sport in laps led (10,996), winning percentage (.164), earnings  
(\$88,893,977) and points (55,592).

As Johnson said after the fourth of his five straight titles, "I've always  
set my marks high -- but I had no clue this stuff would happen."

Johnson locked up his fifth championship by finishing second to Carl  
Edwards in the final race. He came to Homestead-Miami Speedway  
trailing Denny Hamlin by 15 points, but Hamlin struggled all day and  
finished 14th. Kevin Harvick, who finished third in the Ford 400, was 41  
points off the pace.

Hamlin and Harvick made Johnson work and figure to do so again, but  
this is neither horseshoes nor hand grenades, and close doesn't count.

Johnson's mastery is centered in the format known as the Chase. After  
26 races, the standings are redrawn and the 12 drivers then deemed  
worthy to compete for the championship begin what basically are races  
within races for the final 10 events. Beginning in 2006, the first of  
Johnson's five consecutive championship years, not once has he led the  
standings at the end of the regular season. But Johnson has won 19 of the  
70 Chase races since the format was devised in 2004. In second place is  
Carl Edwards with eight.

"Jimmie has had an unbelievable ability to perform in the Chase and  
win championships," said Edwards.

What is a Chase without "hot pursuit"?

Hamlin and Harvick are obviously the most likely to give Johnson a  
run for even more money. Hamlin had more victories than anyone, led the  
standings entering the final race and staked his claim to the ever-  
changing, seldom-true role of heir apparent. Harvick's consistency over  
the course of the season was by far the best. Edwards, who finished fourth  
in the 2010 standings and won the season's final two races, also figures to  
challenge the perennial nature of Johnson titles.

It is a daunting task, however, and they all know it.

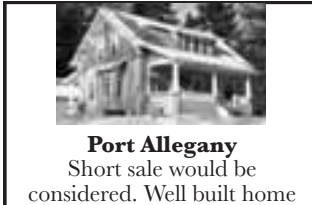

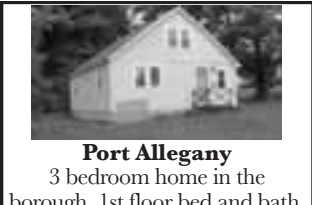

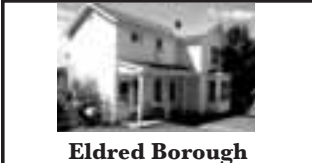

We're heading in the right direction, though, as seen with large and small indications, but we're not there yet.

For one more year: Keep saving, and keep your credit balances low or paid off. Keep shopping at thrift stores, especially for kids clothes and toys. Change your own oil, if you haven't been. Stick to your budget and have pizza and movie night at home. Don't open new lines of credit. Conserve on heating and cooling. Keep up with yard and house maintenance so repairs don't cost you more later.

Aim for having one year of expenses in the bank. Yes, that's a lot, but many people have been out of work for longer than that.

A: Since so many readers have written me recently about Avon collectibles, a brief history lesson might be in order. The California Perfume Company was founded in 1886. Even though the "Avon" line was introduced by the company during the 1920s, it was not marketed as such until 1939. Collecting, especially the earlier items, is still brisk, but prices appear to have softened in recent years. For example, a 1960s globe bank that contained bubble-bath crystals was valued in a 1975 price guide for \$35, and currently retails for about \$15. There are several fairly good price guides available that you can find online at www.amazon.com.

## Slow Cooker Pot Roast with Onions

Serves 4 to 6

- 1 (2 1/2-pound) boneless beef sirloin tip or chuck roast
- 1 tablespoon prepared horseradish
- 1 1/2 pounds yellow onions, trimmed and cut into 1/2-inch slices
- 1 pound Wisconsin red potatoes, trimmed and halved
- 1/2 pound carrots, trimmed, peeled and cut into 2 to 3-inch pieces
- 2 tablespoons fresh thyme leaves, stripped from stems
- 1 tablespoon chopped fresh rosemary (stems removed)
- 2 cups tomato juice
- 1 cup low-sodium beef broth
- 1/2 cup red wine (or additional beef broth)
- 2 tablespoons flour
- Pepper and salt to taste (optional)

Trim fat from beef roast. Place roast in bottom of 5 to 6-quart slow cooker. Spread horseradish over surface of meat. Top and surround roast with onions, potatoes, and carrots. Sprinkle with thyme and rosemary and pour in tomato juice and beef broth. Cover and cook on high setting for 6 to 8 hours or until beef is fall apart tender.

Mix wine (or beef broth) with flour and pour mixture around meat in slow cooker. Gently stir flour mixture into existing sauce without disturbing the meat. Replace cover and cook on high setting for 15 minutes or until thickened. Before serving, season with pepper and salt to taste and garnish with sprigs of rosemary.

## Broccoli, Bacon and Cheddar Chowder

Serves 6

- 8 slices bacon, chopped
- 2 tablespoons unsalted butter
- 1 onion, finely chopped
- 2 tablespoons all-purpose flour
- 1/2 teaspoon salt
- Dash cayenne pepper
- 3 cups milk
- 2 cups chicken or vegetable stock
- 12 ounces Wisconsin red skinned potatoes, cut into 1/2-inch dice
- 2 cups cheddar cheese, shredded
- 1 tablespoon all-purpose flour
- 1 teaspoon hot pepper sauce, if desired
- 2 10-ounce boxes frozen chopped broccoli, thawed

Heat large pot over medium heat. Add bacon and cook until crispy, about 5 minutes. Remove bacon with slotted spoon and transfer to paper towel lined plate and reserve. Pour off all but 2 tablespoons fat. Add butter and onion and cook for 6 minutes or until softened. Add flour and cook, stirring for another 2 minutes or until foamy.

Whisk in salt, cayenne pepper, milk and chicken stock and cook until it becomes smooth and creamy, about 3 minutes. Add potatoes and cook for 10 to 15 minutes or until potatoes are tender.

In bowl, toss cheddar with flour to coat. Stir in cheese, a handful at a time, whisking after each addition until smooth. Add in hot pepper sauce if using. Add thawed broccoli and stir to heat. Do not boil. Taste for seasoning and adjust if necessary.

Ladle soup into heated bowls and garnish with reserved bacon.

## Quick & Healthy Potato Casserole

Serves 6

- 1 1/4 pounds Wisconsin Yukon Gold potatoes, very thinly sliced
- 1 cup quartered and thinly sliced onion
- 1 cup shredded reduced-fat sharp cheddar cheese
- 1/2 teaspoon Italian herb seasoning
- 1/2 cup stock or reduced-sodium broth
- 1 1/2 teaspoons Dijon mustard
- 1/2 teaspoon garlic salt

Spray an 8-inch microwave-safe baking dish with nonstick cooking spray. Place 1/3 of the potatoes and 1/2 of the onions on bottom of dish and sprinkle with 1/3 of the cheese and 1/2 of the herbs. Repeat layers, then top with the last 1/3 of the potatoes, layering potatoes so that there is a solid layer of potatoes with no gaps; sprinkle with remaining cheese.

Stir together stock, Dijon and garlic salt and pour over potatoes. Cover with plastic wrap and microwave on HIGH for 20 minutes. Use oven mitts to remove dish from microwave; carefully remove cover from dish (due to steam build-up) and serve.

**Optional:** Preheat oven to 400°F and place casserole in oven for 5 to 10 minutes or until casserole is golden brown before serving.

## Storage Tips

Onions and potatoes pair well together in lots of recipes. They also like similar storage conditions, but can spoil if stored in proximity to each other. Follow these quick tips for the best possible shelf-life.

- Store potatoes and onions separately. Store onions in cool, dry, well-ventilated places, optimally, at a temperature between 45°F and 55°F, but not in the refrigerator. Potatoes require similar storage conditions, but they also need darkness and should be kept at 50°F or less to avoid sprouting.
- Potatoes can be stored in perforated plastic bags or paper bags to extend their shelf-life.
- Onions should NOT be stored in plastic bags. Lack of air movement reduces storage life.
- Don't wash potatoes or onions (or any produce for that matter) before storing. Dampness will promote early spoilage.
- Chopped or sliced onions can be stored in a sealed container in your refrigerator for up to 7 days.

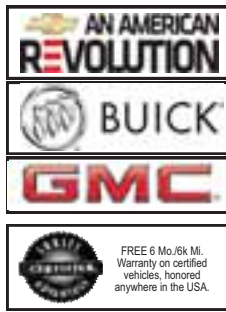
