**PAW'S CORNER**

Choosing a Family Pet

DEAR PAW'S CORNER: We're visiting a breeder soon who is offering a new litter of puppies for sale. She says we should visit a few times to find the right puppy for our family. How do we choose the best of the litter? -- Kay S., Bowden, Ala.

DEAR KAY: I don't think there's always a "best" puppy in a litter. However, there is the right "fit" for your family. For example, outgoing pups may do best with a family, while shy dogs work better with individuals.

The breeder is offering to let you visit several times to find the best fit, which is a great selection method (and one mark of a good breeder). Often, such visits are spaced over several weeks, from a couple weeks after the puppies' birth to the time they are ready to leave (eight or more weeks).

Because you will be spending quite a bit of money on a new dog, be observant during visits and ask questions. Make sure the puppies' living area is clean and that they all look healthy, happy and relaxed. Hold and play with puppies that interest you and watch their behavior around your children. As the weeks pass, observe their growth and the maturation of motor skills and awareness.

The breeder will be observing you during this time as well. After all, she doesn't want to send well-bred puppies to owners who won't care for them. It's not unusual for professional breeders to refuse to sell a puppy to someone they have doubts about. Remember, the deal isn't done until both sides agree that the dog you pick is the best fit for you, and the papers are signed.

### Wee Ones Welcome

While some couples opt not to have children at their wedding, others do. They take great delight in young children and can't fathom having a celebration without them. If you share in this feeling and would like to have children at your wedding, make sure you plan for them accordingly.

If at all possible, hold your wedding in the morning or afternoon. The later your wedding is, the more likely your young guests will become tired and act out of sorts. Those accustomed to going to bed around 8 o'clock may even fall asleep during the celebration, forcing parents to leave early.

Look for a venue that is child friendly. Don't select a hotel with a lot of fine antiques. Young guests will be too tempted to touch all of the

wonderful things surrounding them. Select a hotel with modern decor and make sure there are rooms nearby where young guests can nap if needed. Ask your ushers to seat all parents with young kids near the back of the room during the ceremony so they can leave quickly if needed.

Provide ample entertainment. Even the best-behaved children act up when they get tired and bored. To prevent this at your reception, hand out crayons and coloring books to little ones at tables and set up an area where children can play after dinner. If most of your young guests can handle sitting by themselves, you could set up a separate table for them where they could sit, draw and color together.

in a clown, magician or some other form of entertainment for your young guests. If you are having your reception outdoors, rent a bouncy castle and find a volunteer to supervise the operation. cleaning up the reception site

- Receiving the flowers and handing out all of the bouquets, corsages and boutonnieres
- Helping the bride and bridesmaids get dressed and making sure they get where they need to be at the appropriate time
- Holding the bride's bouquet during the ceremony

- Witnessing the marriage license
- Standing in the receiving line
- Taking part in the wedding photos
- Toasting the couple at the reception
- Dancing with the best man and other guests

Depending upon your wishes, the maid of honor may have more or fewer duties to perform. Sit down and decide exactly what you would like your maid of honor to do. Make a list of their duties and a list of potential candidates for the job. Then start comparing the lists.



TALLADEGA, Ala. -- Know the cartoon where the sheep dog and the wolf -- they're named Ralph E. Wolf and Sam Sheepdog if you're keeping a scorecard at home -- fight all day and then exchange pleasantries as they punch their time cards at the end of each day?

A bit of that dynamic comes into play at Talladega Superspeedway these days, only in reverse. Instead of parting on good terms, Restrictor Plate Racing 7.0 is a program in which everyone plays nice -- or at least attempts to do so -- until the very end.

But the seeming rivals do work together. Some NASCAR fans yearn for the days of rugged individualists and cold-blooded decisions. They want their favorite driver to look out for No. 1. Or, perhaps, No. 88.

In the latest case, many Dale Earnhardt Jr. fans -- we're talking tens of thousands -- tramped to the parking lots and motored home from Talladega Superspeedway grumbling about what a good dude their hero was.

Earnhardt Jr. didn't win the Aaron's 499, but he was instrumental in Jimmie Johnson's victory. Earnhardt concluded long before the finish that the drafting partnership -- races at Talladega and Daytona have become almost an entirely new genre in which drivers race in tandem -- with Johnson worked better with the winner of the past five

championships riding in front.

The trouble, from the perspective of Earnhardt's fans, is that riding behind Johnson makes it impossible for Earnhardt to win. Not that Johnson wasn't a sympathetic figure, mind you. It had been a whole 15 races since the perennial champion's most recent victory.

And Earnhardt has been prospering. Why, he won ... 101 races ago. George W. Bush, no relation to Kyle and Kurt (Busch), was president.

The four drivers at Hendrick Motorsports might as well be ... musketeers. There were four of them, you know: Athos, Portos and Aramis were eventually joined by d'Artagnan. They acted with esprit de corps, morale and several other terms derived from French.

All for one. One for all. Just like Johnson, Earnhardt, Jeff Gordon and Mark Martin.

Earnhardt explained it all matter-of-factly in the style of the swell guy he is.

Dale Earnhardt, Original Recipe, once had teammates. He treated a guy named Mike Skinner as if he were his personal valet. Much, however, has changed since then.



DEAR DAVE: It's not just costly in terms of replacing medical equipment, there's also the risk of Annie having to endure a costly surgery to remove bits of plastic lodged in her digestive tract. However, it can be tough to break a cat of certain habits, and many cats love to gnaw at certain textures and shapes.

If possible, you or your wife should come up with ways to move the oxygen hose (or hoses) out of Annie's reach, either by attaching to the chair with a strip or two of medical tape or, if carrying oxygen around, by looping the excess length of hose around the top of the tank or over one's shoulder.


Another method to consider is spraying the exposed length of hose with a cat repellent. Several types are available at pet stores and are used to deter cats from clawing or gnawing things like furniture or other fascinating protuberances. In either case, constant vigilance is

still required, as Annie will continue to try to bite the hose if she can get close enough (despite the presence of any stinky spray).

When she makes a move toward the hose, distract her with a toy or by calling her. Or, by gently picking her up and placing her in another part of the room, ideally facing a favorite toy or scratching post on which she can take out her energy.

Q: I have two Edison

Diamond Disc 78s, each with a small chip. They feature Billy Wynne's Greenwich Village Inn orchestra, Benny Davis and Joe Burke, Fry's Million Dollar Pier orchestra, and Gus Kahn. -- Jean, Oxford, Conn.

A: The Edison Diamond Disc recordings actually are cut at 80 rpm, not 78 rpm. More importantly, they could not be played on standard machines, and since they required a special Edison player, the quarter-inch discs were soon eclipsed by the more accessible recordings being issued by such companies as Victor, Brunswick and Columbia. Most Edison discs sell in the \$5 to \$10 range, depending on condition and desirability.

Q: I have a copy of "The

Sinking of the Titanic and Great Sea Disasters," edited by Logan Marshall and published in 1912 by L.T. Meyers. It is in good condition, and I would like to know its value. -- Artrischia, Cottage Hills, Ill.

A: I found several copies offered for sale at www.abe.com in the \$45 to \$75 range. I also checked with several used bookstores in Los Angeles, Denver, New York and St. Louis, where I found early editions with average prices of about \$50. As with most collectibles, prices are generally

determined by rarity, demand and condition.


