New York City Department of Health and Mental Hygiene Health Care Access and Improvement

The Division of Health Care Access and Improvement includes a wide variety of programs that provide services to tens of thousands of New Yorkers.

- The Office of Forensic and Behavioral Mental Health Services is responsible for planning, development, evaluation and oversight of forensic mental health services, which include jail based mental health and discharge planning services. The focus of this office is to ensure that all inmates who leave the criminal justice system will have access to the necessary community based mental health services. Upon release clients may seek services at Community SPAN Offices.
- The Bureau of Oral Health, Programs and Policy operates an integrated network of community-based and health center dental clinics, providing comprehensive dental treatment for children and adolescents up to age 21 who are at high risk for dental diseases, and/or who may not otherwise receive professional dental services.
- The Bureau of Transitional Health Care Coordination provides discharge planning services and referrals to meet the medical and social service needs of inmates, reentrants and their families. A primary goal of the Bureau of Transitional Health Care Coordination is to link inmates, reentrants and their families to health information, public health insurance and health and social services in the community.
- The Bureau of Health Insurance Services monitors the performance of the City's Medicaid Managed Care Plans, develops, implements and evaluates education on public health and mental hygiene issues for health care providers in the public and private sectors, and enrolls uninsured New Yorkers into public health insurance programs.

If you are pregnant, MIC staff will help you qualify for the Prenatal Care Assistance Program (PCAP)/Medicaid by preparing and submitting your application. PCAP will cover the cost of your prenatal, labor and delivery, and post-partum care. PCAP will also cover your family planning services for 24 months after you post-partum visit. MIC offers a sliding fee scale for its family planning services (depending on your income, you may pay nothing). MIC accepts payment from certain Medicaid managed care plans.

Hepatitis C spreads only through blood, not through food or casual contact. The people who most need to be tested are those who:

- Ever injected street drugs, even just once or a long time ago
- Had a blood transfusion, received blood products, or had an organ transplant before July 1992
- Ever been on kidney dialysis
- Had unprotected sex with many partners, or with a partner who had Hep C or injected drugs
- Received tattoos from someone other than a licensed professional
- Tested positive for HIV
- Were born in a country with a high Hep C rate, such as Egypt or the Soviet Union



Crystal Meth

Use of methamphetamine (also known as *meth, crystal, Tina, crank, crissy, speed, and tweek*) is increasing in New York City. Recent studies indicate that meth use may increase unsafe sex and raise HIV and STD infection rates among men who have sex with men. In addition to the physical and psychological damage it causes, meth use often leads to compulsive sexual behaviors that increase the spread of HIV and other sexually transmitted infections. Because meth is highly addictive and may significantly alter sexual behavior, it has the potential to become a more serious and widespread problem, especially with regard to increased spread of HIV. Meth use also poses additional dangers to people already infected with HIV. Meth use often results in an intense downward spiral of addiction, which is very difficult to treat.

NYCMA NEW YORK CRYSTAL METH ANONYMOUS

Counseling and Support Groups

NYC Crystal Meth Anonymous is a fellowship of people for whom crystal meth has become a serious problem. The only requirement for membership is a desire to stay clean and lead a sober life. There are no dues or membership lists- each group is expected to be self-supporting through its own contributions. The members of crystal meth anonymous meet regularly to share support and fellowship, and create a safe environment to stay drug free. The NYCMA advocates complete abstinence from crystal meth, alcohol, inhalants, as well as all other mind-altering substances.
